

Paediatrics

The clinic deals with all diseases affecting childhood and some rare diseases. It is the center of reference for North Sardinia in the field of pediatric oncohematology, solid tumors in children and lymphoblastic leukemias.

It is the clinic for insulin-dependent diabetes patients and carries out educational programs for the families (blood glucose monitoring at home, urine tests, amount of insulin dosing in children).

The clinic performs Day Hospital service and the laboratory for diabetes, allergies, oncology and obesity, performs chemotherapy, transfusions and checkups.

The clinic provides services to public schools (nurseries, primary and secondary schools) both at the playroom or the ward dedicated to young patients.

Several charities are engaged in entertaining the children, such as the Happy Clown association. Following Patch Adams' footsteps, 32 volunteer clowns bring joy in the ward of the hospital, where fun and humor are needed. Actors and actresses entertain local children twice a week with readings and plays.

The outpatient medical examination and hospitalization ward, located on the second floor of the clinic, may be accessed directly from the emergency room or during walk-in hours.
