

## Vascular surgery

It is the reference centre for vascular surgery in Northern Sardinia, and conducts the prevention, diagnosis and treatment of vascular diseases.

In particular the clinical activity, carried out in outpatient, inpatient and emergency assistance, provides patients with a qualified supervision and treatment of surgical venous and arterial pathologies including: aortic aneurysms and peripheral arteries, acute and chronic limb ischemia, carotid stenosis, varicose disease, vascular trauma.

The structure also plays a daily service of expert advice for the diagnosis and treatment of vascular medical disorders: Raynaud's disease, Lymphedema, deep vein thrombosis and post phlebotic syndrome, angiodysplasia.

The center is equipped with all the devices and equipment necessary to provide suitable diagnostic and therapeutic: outpatient clinic, outpatient echo-color Doppler and CW Doppler clinic, angiography portable digital device, radio frequency devices for phlebology-related applications.

Patient preparation for surgery is performed in close collaboration with the Services and other related specialties. In particular, the skilled team of angioradiologists performs modern minimally-invasive endovascular surgery operations for arterial diseases, both aneurysmal and steno-obstructive.

The doctors of the structure are engaged in teaching and research at UNISS School of Medicine. The facility also hosts the Specialization School of Vascular Surgery.

### Where to go

Clinics are located on the ground floor of new surgical pavilions; the Secretary is at the 4th floor – B staircase of the 2nd "stecca" (Piandanna side) of new surgical pavilions.

### Hospitalization

Access to the Vascular Surgery takes place both for inpatients and emergency patients.

The planned admission as inpatients is managed by the specialist doctors of the facility, after preliminary examinations, and the patient is added to a waiting list with priority given based on the anatomical and clinical evaluation of the surgeon.

Urgent hospitalization, both required by emergency room of the Hospital Facilities scattered on the territory and by the attending doctor, is accepted by the physicians working in the facility, after office examinations and based on bed availability.
