Graduated in literary subjects specialising in geography at the University of Sassari. Obtained top marks with honours, with a dissertation entitled: *Geographic aspects of the exploitation of prestigious stone resources in Northern Sardinia*. In March 1997, he won a national competition to carry out doctorate research – XII cycle – in *Environmental Geography*, at the University of Sassari. The doctorate research activity ended on 31 October 1999; on 12 January 2000, he obtained a PhD, with a dissertation entitled “*Mining activities, economic benefits and environmental impacts*”.

On 16 September 1996, nominated as subject expert in Economic Geography and Geography of Tourism at the Faculty of Economics at the University of Sassari and, from that date, he has been a member of the exam panels for the aforementioned subjects. The title of subject expert was subsequently extended to the subjects of Environmental politics and Organisation and planning of the Territory at the same university.

In 2000 (October), awarded biennial research funding offered by the Faculty of Economics of the University of Sassari, which was renewed for the following two years. The research focussed on recuperating abandoned mining areas and compared the states of play in Sardinia and Corsica.

Scientific Activity

His scientific training and activity has been carried out at the Institute and laboratory of Geography at the University of Sassari. His interests in research initially focussed on the study of environmental issues related to mining and quarrying activities. This field of study was subsequently broadened to incorporate economic aspects and local development. He has carried out specific research on the territory related to tourism with the perspective of rediscovering and giving value to the hinterland of Sardinia as well as aspects of cartography connected to tourism and the relation between maps and readers. His interest in cartography related themes were further investigated in a study regarding waterways in maps of Italian explorers in Eastern Africa, which brought to light a number of geopolitical implications relative to the historical period in question. In addition, he analysed the geographical aspects of foreign immigration in Sardinia. The preparation and level of scientific knowledge acquired, relative to matters regarding the environment, geo-economics, cartography, tourism and geographic mobility are documented by his scientific production. More recently, his research activity has focussed on the analysis of territorial competitiveness, with particular attention to local touristic dynamics, analysed through the application of specific statistics indicators. The study of territorial performances is discussed in the perspective of politics of regional cohesion, through the observation of socio-economic imbalances and the processes of convergence in the EU. Macroeconomic dynamics are explored as well as their impact on the local environment, in order to create new models of organisation.

Since 2015 he is in charge of the “*Environment and Territory – Data Analysis*” laboratory which carries out scientific research and advanced training in areas related to geography, the environment, territory and society, cartography and historical-geographical areas; promotes projects which entail the implementation of territorial data banks, the use of computerised geographic systems and telematics tools to gain knowledge, manage, develop and preserve the territory; carries out data analysis (*ETL, BI, machine learning, computer*

vision, web analytics).
