

Taxes are raising...unlike fees!

Dear student,

this year, although there are no substantial changes in the amount of tuition fees, there are some major changes in the procedure and the methodology to calculate them.

The inclusion in the ISEE self-certification

This year you do not have to enter your ISEE data, since the information will be acquired via an automatic procedure directly from the INPS database. During the matriculation or the registration renewal procedures, you will need to provide a written consent to the University of Sassari to acquire the information automatically and avoid any material errors.

If you decide not reject such authorization, the highest income bracket will apply.

You will still have to provide the “Dichiarazione Sostitutiva Unica” (DSU) form, that may be issued by any CAF or INPS office.

Note: When you complete the registration procedure, the system is yet to acquire the ISEE data, therefore you will be temporarily assigned to the highest income bracket and the highest registration fee will be set automatically. Following the acquisition of the ISEE data, you will automatically be reassigned to the correct income bracket and fee will be recalculated accordingly.

The calculation of the University fee.

This year's fees are:

Virtual stamp duty	€ 16,00;
Variable registration fee depending on the student's household income (ISEE)	min € 310,00 max € 1.300,00;
Study course fee	min € 90,00
depending on the selected Department	max € 150,00;
Regional fees for the Right to Education	€ 140,00.

To calculate the amount of your registration fee, you may either wait for the University to acquire all necessary ISEE data from INPS (the exact amount will be entered in your “self-studenti” account area, or you can calculate the amount on your own, applying the ISEE value entered in your DSU to the following function:

$$\text{Fee} = a + ((\text{ISEE} - b) * c)$$

and using the parameters reported in the following table:

EXAMPLES:

I am a regular student enrolled in the second year and my DCU ISEE value is € 16,000.00. The registration fee I have to pay (in addition to the stamp duty, the study course fee and the regional ERSU fee) is :

$$515.72 + ((16.000,00 - 15.000,00) * 0.025800)$$

$$\rightarrow 515.72 + (1000 * 0.025800)$$

$$\rightarrow 515.72 + 25.80$$

$$\rightarrow \mathbf{538.52 \text{ €}}$$

I am a **student enrolled in the first supplementary** year and my DCU ISEE value is € 27,000.00. The registration fee that I have to pay (in addition to the stamp duty, the study course fee and the regional ERSU fee) equals:

$$771.75 + ((27.000,00 - 25.000,00) * 0.020494)$$

$$\rightarrow 771.75 + (2000 * 0.020494)$$

$$\rightarrow 771.75 + 40.99$$

$\rightarrow 812.74$ (applicable fee increase by 5% - in this case - mandatory for students enrolled in the 1st supplementary year).

$$\rightarrow \mathbf{853,38 \text{ €}}$$

Payment of the registration fee.

Payment of tuition fees is split into three installments:

the first installment includes a part of the registration fee amounting to € 200.00, a € 16.00 virtual duty stamp and the study course fee; it is calculated at the end of the registration procedure or on-line registration and is payable immediately.

The remaining two installments include the remaining amount of the registration fee (divided equally between both installments) and the ERSU fee (distributed entirely on the second installment) and are available for payment only after the University acquires the ISEE data from INPS.

Payment of tuition fees should only occur via MAV forms issued by the system, since it is the only way to ensure a successful update of your administrative profile.
